Proactive Road Maintenance

Council contractors have been kept busy completing various crack sealing projects. Crack sealing helps extend the life of road pavements by preventing water ingress and damage, reducing further cracking, and delaying costly repairs. It's a smart, cost-effective way to maintain smoother, safer roads.
