

Building permit application checklist

Swimming pools and spas

This document can be submitted with your application as a summary of the documents submitted for approval.

2	Payment of Council Building Permit fees and State Government Levies	
3	Full and current copy of <u>property title</u> , along with copies of the title plan, restrictions, covenants or agreements, details of easements (eg) stormwater drainage, sewerage, etc.	
4	Builder's Warranty Insurance Certificate for works exceeding \$16,000 in value or Owner Builder Certificate of Consent for works exceeding \$16,000 in value.	
5	2 copies of site plan (refer example on page 2)	
6	2 copies of the structural engineer's drawings, computations and Certificate of Compliance – Design	
7	Provide details of the recirculation and filtration system including skimmer box	
8	Reporting Authority Consents (e.g.) Lower Murray Water, Places Victoria (Tower Hill Only), Septic Tank/Drains, Council Engineering Department, etc.	
9	Provide details of compliant swimming pool safety barriers to AS1926.1-2012 including specific details such as the construction of boundary fences, notations and diagrams in relation to swing and location of gates latch details and clear arc areas	
10	Provide details of pool heating (note: must be solar heating)	
11	Confirm provision of time switch to control the operation of the circulation pump	
12	1 copy of Domestic Building Works Contract for works exceeding \$16,000	
13	Other	

Note:

This summary of documents to be submitted for approval is offered as a guide only and does not limit the power of the Municipal Building Surveyor to request any additional information as deemed necessary to demonstrate that the building will, if constructed in accordance with the documents lodged, comply with the Building Act 1993 and Building Regulations 2018.

Site plan requirements

General details required to be shown on site plans submitted for building permit applications. An example has been provided below to assist you in the preparation of this document.

Site plan (drawn to a scale of 1:250 min.) must include:

- The allotment boundaries and dimensions as shown on the Title.
- The street name and number next to the front boundary of the allotment.
- The north point for the allotment.
- Easement locations and dimensions as shown on the Title.
- The location of the proposed swimming pool or spa.
- The location of the existing buildings.
- The location of existing septic tank/drains (where applicable)
- The setbacks of the proposed swimming pool or spa from the allotment boundaries and any other adjoining buildings.
- The dimensions of the proposed structure.
- Label the new swimming pool or spa as “**proposed**” and the existing buildings as “**existing**”.
- Indicate location and type of compliant safety barriers in accordance with AS1926.1 – 2012.
