

Notes on submissions to Planning Scheme Amendments

1. A submission about an amendment need not be made on this form. The form is to help people make submissions which can be understood by the planning authority.
2. To make a submission you should clearly complete the details on the front of this form and lodge it with the planning author as shown on the Notice of Amendment to a Planning Scheme. If your submission concerns property other than where you live, give details of that property and of your interest in it.
3. To ensure that the planning authority considers your submission, it should receive it by the date shown in the notice you were sent or saw in the newspaper or Government Gazette.
4. If the planning authority does not agree to change the amendment as requested in your submission, the Minister for Planning will appoint an independent Panel to consider the matter and you will be given an opportunity to be heard by the Panel.
5. Do not use this form to object to an application for a permit to use or develop land.

Personal Information

The personal information on this form is collected by Swan Hill Rural City Council (Responsible Authority) for the purpose of considering your submission under the Planning & Environment Act 1987 (the Act). If you do not provide the prescribed information, Council will not be able to consider your submission.

You must not submit any personal information or copyrighted material of third parties without their informed consent. By submitting the material, you agree that the use of the material as detailed above does not breach any third party's right to privacy and copyright.

Personal Information includes:
