Prime Cattle Sale 24th of September 2020

Agents yarded nearly 740 head at this week's SHRLE Prime Cattle Market, somewhat smaller than the previous fortnight. Few Cows offered, only a few pens of heavy beef making to 315c/kg while dairy types sold to 270c/kg. The market suited feed-lotters and re-stockers, with all our regular domestic operating, seeing Autumn drop calves starting to make an appearance. The best shaped steer and heifer quotations made to 435c/kg and 380c/kg respectively. Processors benefited from the main run of heavy yearlings averaging 412c/kg. The few heavy grown steers sold strongly to top at 396c/kg. Overall the market saw a 5c/kg to 10c/kg defecate on last fortnight's quotations.
